**Classroom Educator Training—June 27-July 1, 2022** (*attendance is mandatory for the week*)

Course Fee: **\$650** (does not include texts—the trainee will be responsible for purchasing the texts and will be given the ones to purchase)

This training springboards into the Associate Level training but is a minimum 30-hour training. This training is designed for teachers working in classrooms or with small groups and is not intended for 1:1 instruction. Topics covered include: dyslexia and reading disorders; the OG Approach; phonology and phonological awareness; handwriting; phonics for reading and spelling; the lesson plan; history and structure of the English language; beginning morphology; informal assessments and diagnostic-prescriptive teaching; and accuracy, automaticity, and fluency.

*A minimum 50-hour practicum with a minimum of five observations is offered at an additional fee of \$75/observation in order to complete the requirements needed to apply to the Academy at the Classroom Educator Level, which will allow you to state you are “Orton-Gillingham Trained.”*

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***This structured and systematic training strives to increase teachers’ knowledge and effectiveness in working with students who have dyslexia and language-learning difficulties. It is an intensive course that provides opportunities for a variety of hands-on exercises which advance the understanding of specific procedures of the Orton-Gillingham Approach and the underlying science, research, and principles in teaching reading, spelling, and written expression.***

**Participation in this trainings requires a minimum of a 4-year college degree, not necessarily related to education.**
