What is it like to have dyslexia?

Experience Dyslexia®, developed by the Northern California Branch of the IDA, is a dyslexia simulation workshop.

Lakes and Bridges Charter School is pleased to present this workshop to the community.

The simulation is a hands-on experience that lets participants experience some of the challenges and frustrations that people with dyslexia face each day. The simulation provides a lively, thought-provoking experience for those interested in better understanding the person with dyslexia.

What happens during a simulation?

The workshop consists of learning stations that simulated different language-related learning tasks encountered in the classroom or workplace. The facilitator will guide participants through each activity, followed by a brief discussion.

When all participants have completed the activities, there will be a general debriefing.

The entire workshop lasts approximately 2 hours.
